NATO chief: Ukraine's 'rightful place' is in the alliance

KYIV, Ukraine — NATO chief Jens Stoltenberg defiantly declared Thursday that Ukraine's "rightful place" is in the military alliance and pledged more support for the country on his first visit to Kyiv since Russia's invasion just over a year ago.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy urged Stoltenberg, who has been instrumental in marshaling support from NATO members, to push for even more from them, including warplanes, artillery and armored equipment.

The Kremlin has given various justifications for going to war, but repeated Thursday that preventing Ukraine from joining NATO is still a key goal of its invasion, arguing that Kyiv's membership in the alliance would pose an existential threat to Russia.

NATO leaders said in 2008 that Ukraine would join the alliance one day, and Stoltenberg has repeated that promise throughout the war, though the organization has established no pathway or timetable for membership.

"Let me be clear, Ukraine's rightful place is in the Euro-Atlantic family," Stoltenberg told a news conference. "Ukraine's rightful place is in NATO."

Zelenskyy said he was grateful for an invitation to a NATO summit in July in Vilnius, Lithuania, but said his country needs a roadmap for becoming a member.

"The time has come for the [alliance's] leaders to define the prospects of Ukraine's acquisition of NATO membership, to define the algorithm of Ukraine's movement towards this goal, and to define security guarantees for our state for the period of such movement — that is, for the period before NATO membership," he said.

Stoltenberg said he and Zelenskyy discussed a NATO support program for Ukraine.

"This will help you transition from Soviet-era equipment and doctrines to NATO standards and ensure full interoperability with the alliance," Stoltenberg said. "NATO stands with you today, tomorrow and for as long as it takes."

He noted an announcement Thursday by Denmark and the Netherlands that they plan to provide Ukraine with at least another 14 refurbished Leopard 2 battle tanks by early 2024.

He added that he expected countries to "make new announcements of concrete military support to Ukraine" at a meeting Friday in Germany.

In other developments, a large explosion hit the Russian city of Belgorod late Thursday, and the Defense Ministry said one of its Su-34 warplanes accidentally discharged ammunition over the city

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Belgorod regional Gov. Vyacheslav Gladkov said the blast injured at least two people, damaged homes and left a crater about 65 feet across.

The fighting in recent months has become a war of attrition, with neither side able to gain momentum. But Ukraine has recently received sophisticated weapons from its Western allies and is expected to launch a counteroffensive in coming weeks.

Russian President Vladimir Putin has warned that Moscow could use "all means available" — a phrase some see as a threat to use nuclear weapons — in response to an attack on its territory if Ukraine attempts to recapture Moscow-occupied areas.

NATO has no official presence in Ukraine and provides only nonlethal support to Kyiv, but Stoltenberg has been the strong voice of the al-

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A procession of international leaders has made the journey to Kyiv over the last year, and the former Norwegian prime minister is one of the last major Western figures to do so.

NATO, formed to counter the Soviet Union, has long feared being dragged into a wide war with nuclear-armed Russia. But as the West has moved from hesitantly providing helmets and uniforms to tanks, warplanes and advanced missile systems, high-level visits have become routine.

Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said Thursday that preventing Ukraine from joining NATO remains one of the goals of what Moscow calls its "special military operation." Speaking in a conference call with reporters, Peskov said that Ukraine's accession would pose a "serious, significant threat to our country, to our country's security."

Sudan army demands rivals' surrender as cease-fire runs out

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A tenuous 24-hour cease-fire that began the previous day ran out Thursday evening with no word of extension. The military's statement raised the likelihood of a renewed surge in the nearly week-long violence that has killed hundreds and pushed Sudan's population to the breaking point. Alarm has grown that the country's medical system was on the verge of collapse, with many hospitals forced to shut down and others running out of supplies.

The expiring truce had failed to put a stop to fight-

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Thursday afternoon, the military said in a statement that it would not negotiate with its rival, the Rapid Support Forces, and would only discuss the terms of its surrender. "There would be no armed forces outside [of] the military system," it said.

The demise of the truce, the second attempt this week, underscored the failure of the United States, U.N., European Union and regional powers to push Sudan's top generals to halt their campaigns to seize control of the country. Instead, army chief Gen. Abdel Fattah Burhan and RSF commander Gen. Mohammed Hamdan Dagalo each appear deter-

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The U.S. military is moving assets to a base in the Horn of Africa nation of Djibouti for a possible evacuation of American Embassy personnel, administration officials said. Japan plans to send military planes to Djibouti, and the Netherlands has dispatched its own to Jordan.

U.N. Secretary-General António Guterres appealed for the combatants to commit to a three-day cease-fire to coincide with the holiday of Eid al-Fitr, beginning Friday, marking the end of the Islamic holy month of Ramadan. "We are living a very important moment in the Muslim calendar. I think this is the right moment for a cease-fire to

hold," he told reporters.

4/20 marked at region's first cannabis dispensary

Customers have flocked to Schenectady's Upstate Canna Co. since the store opened at the start of the month, but shoppers had extra reason to celebrate on Thursday as they marked 4/20, the unofficial national holiday for cannabis consumers.

The Capital Region's first cannabis dispensary is one of only eight dispensaries officially licensed by the state currently open for business statewide.

A line of customers stretched down the block on Thursday afternoon, with shoppers eager to get their turn in the store.

Samira Sangare was celebrating her birthday on 4/20, giving the Clifton Park resident two reasons to make her first trip to the Schenectady store.

"It's the first recreational dispensary in the area and it's the closest one to my house," she said. "Usually I go to Mass., but this is super convenient."

Additional shoppers in line said they use cannabis products to treat a range of ailments including Crohn's disease and tinnitus.

Upstate Canna Co. owner Don Andrews said lines outside the 1613 Union St. shop have been steady since the dispensary opened three weeks ago.

"It's been pretty much the same rollout since April 1," he said. "Maybe there'll be a little more business after work (Thursday) when people get out of work. But really it's been kind of consistent."

Andrews said the shop has been able to keep up its inventory in the face of

constant demand from the community.

"All of our cultivators and processors are basically right here in the Capital Region area," he said on Thursday. "We're in good contact with them, so if we run out of stuff, they'll have it to us the same day or the next day at the very latest."

The store consistently hears from customers who previously used to trek to Massachusetts to buy legal cannabis who now shop at the Schenectady dispensary instead, Andrews said.

"So many, every day," he said on Thursday. "Even people from Mass. who live there are coming here because they're saying the product is different from the Massachusetts market."

Dasean Callaway traveled from the Bay State on Thursday to shop at Upstate Canna Co., despite the proliferation of dispensaries in Massachusetts since the commonwealth legalized cannabis in 2018.

"It's about the quality and customer service," Callaway said of the Schenectady store. "I came from Mass. It's a way of life. I just don't live in states that don't agree with the way I live."

New York legalized adult-use cannabis in the state for residents 21 years of age and older in 2021.

In addition to a strong contingent of Saratoga Springs and Clifton Park clients, the store has also seen IDs from Texas, Florida, Nevada and Georgia during the customer check-in process.

The shop offers edibles, vape pens and THC-infused drinks, but Andrews said that cannabis flowers have represented 70% of the shop's

sales so far.

The store will begin offering pick-up orders next week, with plans to introduce delivery service within a 10-mile radius beginning May 1.

Upstate Canna Co. was not offering any deals to celebrate 4/20.

"It's very strict what we can and can't do," Andrews said. "So we're following OCM (New York State Office of Cannabis Management) guidance and compliance. But we're open all day for our normal hours (9 a.m. to 11 p.m.) and people are coming by and checking out the product, but it's the same prices we always have."

Andrews said the store has been welcomed by the local business community since

their opening.

"We haven't had any issues," he said on Thursday. "We've had people who live in these surrounding neighborhoods come in and shake hands with staff and just

greet us and welcome us to

the neighborhood. We've had local business owners tell us how happy they are that we're here and that they're reaping the benefits from the influx of people on Upper

Union Street."

After rain, flooding, New England braces for Hurricane Lee

PORTLAND, Maine (AP) — Days of wild weather that produced torrential rain, flooding, sinkholes and a tornado in New England could be a prelude to something more dangerous lurking offshore — Hurricane

Lee.

As the Category 1 system swirled southwest of Bermuda, Maine Gov. Janet Mills declared a state of emergency on Thursday, and the state was under its first hurricane watch in 15 years. The water-logged region prepared for 20-foot waves and wind gusts up to 70

mph, along with more rain.

A dangerous storm surge was projected for Friday evening for Massachusetts' Cape Cod Bay and Nantucket Island, while the brunt of the storm was to arrive early Saturday.

Although Lee did not contribute to the recent flooding, it threatened to exacerbate conditions in a region that is already much too wet.

The Coast Guard and emergency management agencies warned New England residents to be prepared, and utility companies brought in reinforcements to deal with power outages. At Boothbay Harbor Marina in Maine, the community came together to remove boats from the water to keep them out of harm's way.

"It's a batten-down-the-hatches kind of day," owner Kim Gillies said Thursday.

Similar scenes played out at Kennebunkport Marina, where crews planned to take 100 boats out of the water, said Cathy Norton, marina manager.

Commercial lobster fisherman Steve Train said fishermen have been sinking gear in deeper water to protect against storm damage. Fishing boats were also headed to the safety of harbors.

In Canada, where the remnants of Hurricane Fiona a year ago washed houses into the ocean, knocked out power to most of two provinces and swept a 72-year-old woman into the sea, residents of western Nova Scotia and southern New Brunswick were warned to prepare for power outages and flooding this weekend.

New Brunswick Minister of Public Safety Kris Austin urged residents to assemble a 72-hour safety kit that included batteries, water, food, medication and a radio.

In her emergency declara-

tion on Thursday, the governor urged people to take the storm seriously and to make preparations. Mills, a Democrat, also asked President Joe Biden to issue a preemptive presidential disaster declara-

tion to give the state access to federal resources.

Earlier in the week, the region saw 10 inches of rain over six hours. Tornado warnings were posted Wednesday for communities in Massachusetts

and Rhode Island, and more heavy rain opened up sinkholes and brought devastating flooding to several areas.

The National Weather Service in Boston confirmed Thursday that damage to trees and power lines in Rhode Island and Connecticut the day before was consistent with a tornado. In Lincoln, Rhode Island, photos taken after the storm showed that at least one roof was damaged, and the press box at the high school stadium tipped into the bleachers.

At midday Thursday, Lee was spinning 245 miles southwest of Bermuda, with maximum sustained winds of 90 mph, according to the National Hurricane Center. It was traveling north on a path that could lead to landfall in Nova Scotia, possibly as a tropical storm, forecasters said.

The system threatened to bring a mixed bag of threats. Ocean waves as tall as 20 feet could lash the coast, damaging structures and causing erosion; powerful wind gusts could knock down trees weakened by a wet summer; and rain could cause flash flooding in a region where the soil is already saturated, said Louise Fode, a National Weather Service meteorologist in Maine.

The state's eastern coast — known as the Down East region — and the coast of Nova Scotia was expected to bear the brunt of the storm, though the track could shift before the system arrives, Fode said.

One thing working in the region's favor: The storm surge will not be accompanied by an astronomical high tide, helping to lower the risk, she said.

New England has experienced its share of flooding this summer, including a storm that dumped up to two months of rain in two days in Vermont in July, resulting in two deaths. Scientists are finding that storms around the world are forming in a warmer atmosphere, making extreme rainfall more frequent.

Massachusetts Gov. Maura Healey issued a state of emergency late Tuesday following "catastrophic flash flooding and property damage" in two counties and other communities. The torrential downpour in a six-hour period was a "200-year event," said Matthew Belk, a meteorologist with the National Weather Service in Boston.

The state is monitoring the conditions of dams, the governor said, and she urged residents to stay off the roads when ordered.
