Pursuant to resolution # 22 of the Town of Glen Town Board's position on the proposed application of ConnectGen Montgomery County LLC

The potential application of ConnectGen, LLC plans to apply to ORES to install Solar Photovoltaic Modules with a proposed Nameplate capacity of 100 MW to be located solely in the Town of Glen, Montgomery County, NY. New York Independent System Operator (NYISO) Interconnection Queue (Q#1231) currently lacks a NYS PSC Article 10/ORES case number. "ConnectGen expects to install up to 100 Megawatts of Solar energy in the projected area." The Town is not aware of the meets and bounds of this proposal as it lacks description. The project has submitted an interconnection request (Q1231). This project will seek state siting permit under section 94-c through ORES.

The Town of Glen through the Town Board hereby seeks intervention to insure this second proposed project by ConnectGen, described herewith, located in the Town of Glen to be fully vetted and reviewed solely under the application process as a new application. The Town Board of the Town of Glen fully recognizes intent and objects to ConnectGen leveraging any engagement and feedback of previous public meetings and Environmental Impacts of any other application by ConnectGen in the Town of Glen. To refer to Mill Point 2 as an expansion of a previous application of Mill Point 1 (Q1031) is a gross overreach lacking the mandated substantial review required through the compliance siting process you are required to provide.

In fact, Mill Point 2 is not an expansion of any previous application. As stated, this application will require separate interconnections(Q#1231) approval for adequate availability to the grid, additional Environmental Impacts, Public Health, Safety, and Design of solar energy projects in the Town of Glen. The Town would fully expect required community meetings, municipal engagement and transparency in the application certification process with the full understanding of the area being discussed in the proposal. This evolving process throughout all phases of the section 94-c review process (pre-application phase, application phase, hearing and decision phase, and post-certification phase) must not be minimized at the expense of the Town or convenience of the applicant.
